Employability Skills



Learning objectives:

- To raise pupils awareness of the types of skills that exist and their importance.
- To explain the importance of transferable skills.

Key Ideas:

- Know what the key employability skills are.
- Understand the variety of employability skills
- Understand how these skills can be used in the workplace.

Starter:

Explain the learning Objectives for the sessions.

Explain the importance of the employability skills and the 13 different types.

Main:

Split students into groups of 6. This may be smaller dependent of the size of the group.

Explain the Eiffel tower challenge.

- You have been challenged to build the highest free-standing structure that can support the weight of the golf ball
- The structure must not be fixed to the desk
- The golf ball must not be fixed to the structure
- The golf ball must be held within 20cm of the top of the tower
- You can use any of the items in your pack
